Soap Care Guide

We always recommend that soaps are purchased sliced and wrapped, if you have chosen to slice the soap yourself please follow the slicing guide in our FAQ section of our website www.thesoaphouse.co.uk a highlight of the instructions to help with slicing and storing soap and other products in that section are detailed below:

- * Always allow soap to reach an ambient room temperature before slicing
- * Always use a smooth non serrated blade knife to slice soap to avoid marking the soap and splitting layers, we accept no responsibility for soap splitting when sliced by the customer.
- * Always take care to avoid injury when using knives and keep out of the way of children.
- * Slice the Soap in one smooth motion pushing the knife firmly and evenly through the soap.
- * We recommend that you keep your soap wrapped at all times, keep loaves/cakes/slabs wrapped whole, once sliced immediately re wrap the soap and slices. We recommend that the best way of wrapping soap slices is to use our cello roll wrap available on our website.
- * If you are unsure of how to slice your soap or how to handle a suitable knife please request that your soap be sliced by ourselves. We have the proper equipment and experience to safely carry out slicing.
- * Some soaps are prone to change colour over time, this is due to the nature of the fragrance contained in them, soaps affected by this are detailed within their descriptions on our website.
- * Soaps and bath bombs should be stored cool, dry place out of direct sunlight and always wrapped in suitable wrapping. We always recommend that you purchase your products wrapped and keep them in wrapping once delivered to you.
